System Pressure Advisory!

The water consumers of the Lake Waccamaw Water System in Columbus County are experiencing periods of low pressure and outages in the distribution system due to a **Leaking Water Main near 508 E. Old Hwy 74/76**. Periods of low or no pressure in the distribution system increases the potential for back siphonage and introduction of bacteria into the water system.

Therefore, the Division of Water Resources advised that when water is restored consumers **boil all water** used for human consumption (including drinking, making ice, brushing teeth, washing dishes and food preparation) **or use bottled water**.

Vigorous boiling for one (1) minute should kill any disease-causing organisms that may be present in the water.

This office is strongly urging the water consumers to conserve water whenever possible. **This advisory remains in effect until further written notification is issued.**

This advisory is issued from 508 E. Old HWY 74/76 Little Wheel of Hope Church and continues down E. Old Hwy 74/76 including the side streets of Powell St., Mt. Zion St., Schulken St., James Ave., Wananish Ave., Fire Tower Rd. AND includes East Columbus High school.
